Locally known as “Flinty”, visit the famous Josiah Flintabbatey Flonatin statue created by cartoonist Al Capp.
Once a Canadian National Railway station (built in 1934), the Flin Flon Station Museum was founded by Red McIntosh. In 1983, the Chamber of Commerce purchased the building and moved it to its present location. Tour the museum, home to mining, transportation and cultural artifacts – including an antique diving suit used during the development of the Island Falls Power Station and a 63lb Lake Trout caught in the area.

8:40am Tour of the Northern Manitoba Mining Academy

Located in one of Manitoba's most prolific mining belts in the world, the Northern Manitoba Mining Academy provides mining and construction-related trades training. Working in partnership with UCN and the Manitoba Heavy Construction Association, NMMA provides world-class facilities for field-based undergraduate courses as well as graduate students and researchers doing field work. Tour their facilities, and experience the underground mining simulator.

10:30am Tour of Whitney Forum – Home of the Flin Flon Bombers

Born and raised in Flin Flon, MB, Bobbie Clark is a Hockey Hall of Fame member, and led the Philadelphia Flyers to two Stanley Cup Championships in the 1970s. He is one of many NHLers hailing from Flin Flon, Ken Baird, Ken Baumgartner, Matt Davidson, Kim Davis, Dean Evason, Al Hamilton, Ted Hampson, Gerry Hart, Ron Hutchinson, George Konik, Ray Maluta, Tom Gilmore, Dunc McCallum, Eric Nesterenko, Mel Pearson, Reid Simpson, David Struch, and Ernie Wakely. Tour the facility, which houses an indoor skating arena, walking track, and the Bombers Hall of Fame, and learn about the facility's importance to the community more than 60 years later.
