Overview

Manitoba Race to Reduce Action Award recognizes buildings that have demonstrated their commitment to energy efficiency through concrete efforts completed since joining the Race. The aim of this award is to celebrate buildings that have leveraged Manitoba Race to Reduce resources and materials to engage building occupants and strive for energy reductions to help us reach our collective goal.

Anyone who has undertaken a minimum of four of the following initiatives since joining the Race will be recognized at our awards ceremony!

- Conducted lobby event or lunch learn to make tenants aware of your building's participation in Race to Reduce
- Put up Race to Reduce marketing materials in office (minimum of 10 items)
- Created a Race team or Green Team in your building
- Switched to a daytime cleaning schedule
- Conducted an energy audit
- Conducted an energy efficiency treasure hunt
- Implemented a green lease policy or incorporated green lease language into existing lease(s)
- Designated someone to review and update Portfolio Manager including pulling reports on a regular basis
- Conducted a survey to assess how individuals in your building are using energy and improvements that can be made
- Implemented a new technology to help manage energy consumption such as an Energy Management Dashboard or Manitoba Hydro Network Energy Management Program
- Undertaken a commercial building upgrade to conserve energy (i.e. lighting retrofit, upgrading appliances to more energy efficient models, improved insulation etc.)

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the Manitoba Race to Reduce Action Award, your application must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be listed as a primary Race to Reduce contact for your participating building
- Initiatives must have started between 2017 and 2020 in order to be eligible.

Evaluation Process

Submissions will be reviewed and evaluated by an awards committee. Once your application has been received, Manitoba Race to Reduce may contact you to request supporting documentation to validate the information provided in your application.
